- Lead & input to the technical requirements, scope definition & design of IT Projects
- Complete projects in infrastructure services including complex Server & Storage implementations & migrations.

- Ensures that resources are used efficiently at all times
- Ensure that the project is delivered on time and within budget and that it meets or exceeds expectations.
